NO chairs beyond white line it obstructs lifeguards view for safety.

Selling your home? All Homeowners - you must have your attorney call the Village IV Business Office at (630) 960-2850 for a Closing Package. This package is required to close on your home. Closing Package Fee - Call the VIV Business Office for info. Please allow the VIV Business Office at least two weeks to process the closing package for your home.	Monthly payments are due on the 1st of each month. A grace period of 14 days is allowed before late fees apply. Any payments re- ceived after the 15th of the month incur a late fee. The Clubhouse Office currently accepts checks and cash (exact amount only, change cannot be provided) for dues payments. There is also an option for members in good standing (no past due balances) to pay online with a PayPal account (convenience fees ap- ply). www.village-iv.org	There is a drop box at the Clubhouse en- trance where payments can be placed any time. Do not place cash in the drop box. If you choose to pay with cash, please stop by when an attendant is on duty so we can provide a receipt. Many banks offer options to set up recur- ring payments at no cost to you. Check with your bank to set up Village IV as a vendor that gets paid monthly. Be sure to include your account number and address when setting us up.
